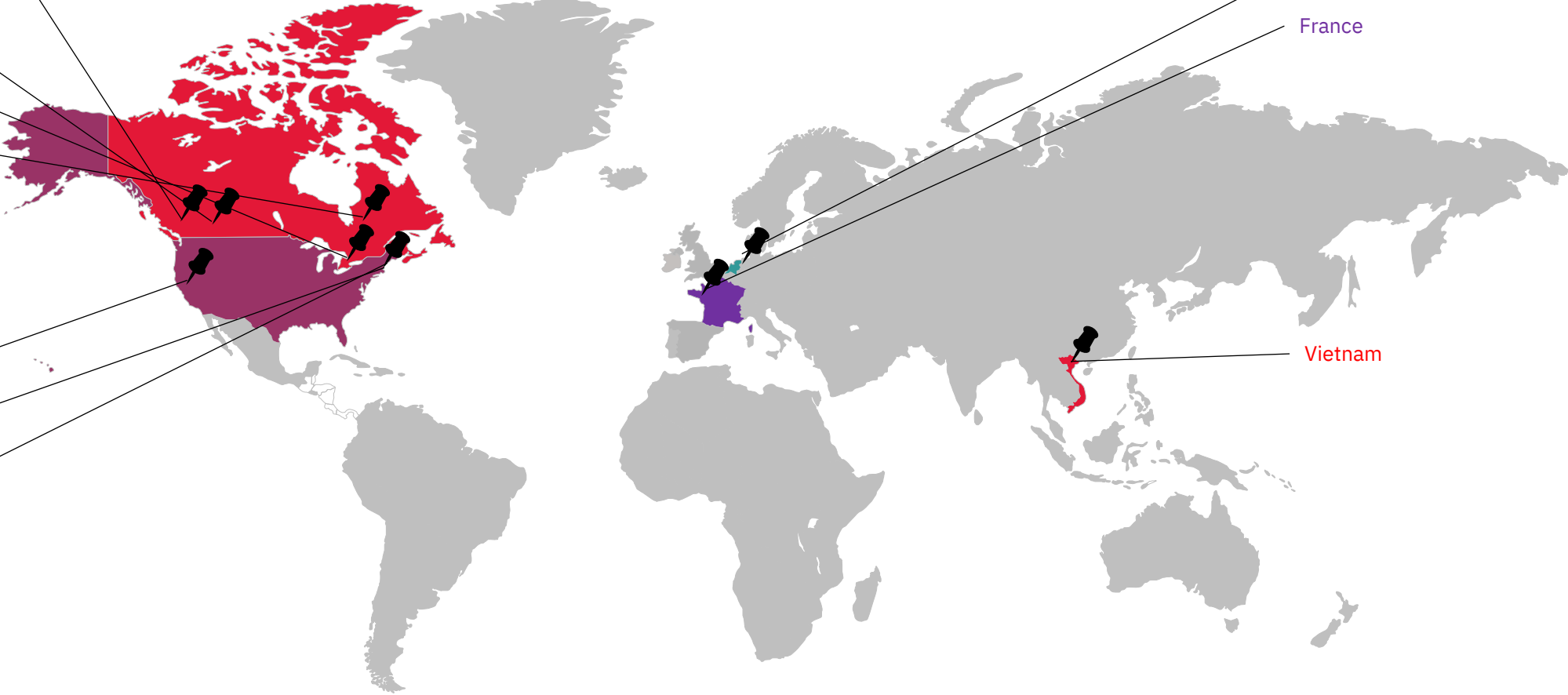

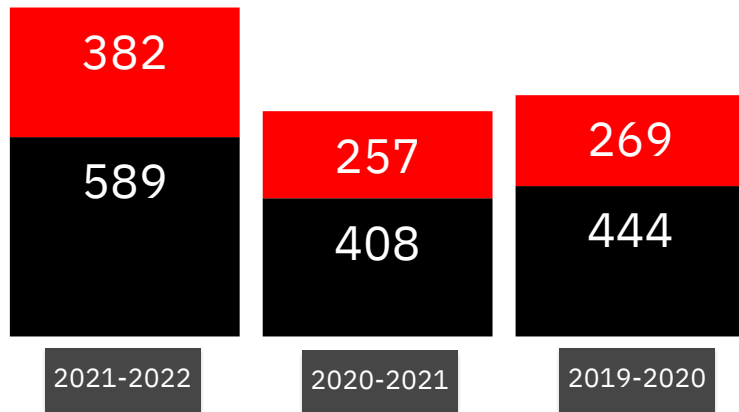


Program Growth 2021-2022

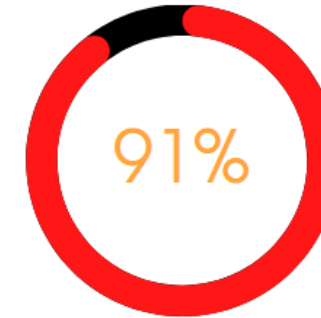
