Amount: \$6,000

Field of Study: Humanities, including: English Language and Literature, History, Languages Study, Classics, Philosophy, Film Studies, Communication Studies, and Culture Studies

Description: Post-secondary students pursuing a degree in the humanities field

5. Ontario Power Generation: University Engineering Award

Deadline: N/A

Amount: \$2,400

Field of Study: Electrical, computer, mechanical, chemical, environmental, or nuclear engineering

The applicant must be currently enrolled full-time and be in their second year of an electrical, computer, mechanical, chemical, environmental or nuclear engineering program
