RESTRICTIONS



- While Philosophy is listed as a humanities or social science subject area, **PHIL 2100 3.00 Introduction to Logic does not count** towards Complementary Studies
- Quantitative courses focusing on techniques of mathematics or statistics **cannot count** (e.g., MODR 1650 6.00 Modes of Mathematical Reasoning)
- Courses within the humanities and social sciences which are **cross-listed with the Faculty of Science (SC) cannot count** towards the “minimum 3 credits in humanities or social science” (e.g., AP/HIST 2810 3.00 History of Modern Science is cross-listed to SC/STS 2010 3.00 and therefore **does not count** towards Complementary Studies)

NEED TO KNOW

- > **NEW:** The restriction that “*No more than 6.00 credits may be taken at the 1000-level*” has been **removed** from the Academic Calendar. Students may complete their Complementary Studies credits at any year level.
- > **NEW:** Students following the 2023-2024 Academic Calendar for Complementary Studies, note that Disaster and Emergency Management is **no longer considered a humanities or social science** subject area.
- > **NEW:** If you have completed one of the **approved SC/STS courses from slide 2**, [connect with an Academic Advisor](#) and we will update your Degree Progress Report accordingly.
- > Many 3000-level courses are eligible for complementary studies credit, but students must have the required prerequisites and be confident of their ability to handle course work in that subject area.
- > The complete criteria for Complementary Studies, including the list of approved subject areas and courses, is available for you in the [Academic Calendar](#). Not all courses are offered every year.
